Bracing Yourself for Today's Security Challenges

Hackers and information thieves, both inside and outside of organizations, are accelerating their attacks on customer and enterprise data. And the challenges are many, including the loss of control that can come through third party vendor relationships, the difficulty managing all the endpoints, data loss and the very difficult balancing act between costs, complexity and risks. This lunch and learn session will examine today's environment, including the value of a holistic, end to end security approach, some perspectives on best practices and an overview of IBM's security capabilities.

SPEAKER - Phil McHugh Americas Security Executive IBM Internet Security Systems

Pro-action is necessary in our changing environment. Phil McHugh has worked for IBM for 28 years, and joined IBM Internet Security Systems (ISS) in '07 to help lead ISS' sales integration into the broader IBM Corp. Across the US, he meets regularly with senior executives in small and medium sized businesses, discussing their security challenges and sharing with them what he's seeing across the country in security. He's a Rutgers University MBA, has worked with many IBM clients since 1982 and was an IBM Client Executive for one of IBM's 10 largest global clients. Immediately prior to joining ISS, he worked for IBM Global Financing (IGF) where he was the executive responsible for launching IGF's first of a kind Vendor Program initiative, resulting in contracts with several non-IBM IT companies for each to use IGF financial services in their go to market product and channel strategies.
